- 8. What is one burden you have trouble laying at Jesus' feet? How does trusting Jesus change the way you face family tension or emotional stress?

Advent—The Season of Expectation

The Advent season is a four-week period in the Christian calendar that prepares people for Jesus Christ's birth at Christmas, while also pointing ahead to his promised return. Each Sunday of the season traditionally spotlights a key theme—like hope, peace, joy, or love—to invite reflection and expectant celebration. It's a season that includes practices like prayer, lighting candles, giving to those in need, and worship. Advent reminds us that we're living during the time between Jesus' first and second advents, leading us to lament the hardships we experience in a still-broken world, while also forming us into people who wait with longing for the renewed world to come.

For Advent 2025, we will be hearing from several members of our CDA Bible Church staff. Here's how things are lined up regarding the Sunday morning events/messages:

THE MERCY TREE

"Mercy" in Scripture, is often understood as bringing healing, comfort, and care to those in distress or suffering. A profound example of this is Jesus' story of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10): When Jesus asked who the beaten and injured man's neighbor was, the answer was obvious – the one who showed him *mercy*. The one who carried him to the inn, who bandaged his wounds, and who cared for his well-being during his time of suffering.

We hope to be like that Good Samaritan in our community this Christmas Season! For the 2025 Christmas season, we are asking you, the church-family of CDA Bible, to join in this ministry of mercy toward our community. The Mercy Tree will be filled with ornaments representing Christmas gifts and other needs for neighbors in our community: simple things we can provide to show mercy to those who may be in distress this holiday season. We will be partnering once again with Angel Tree to provide gifts on behalf of incarcerated parents to their children; as well as providing gifts and gift cards to Open Arms families, residents at UGM's Women's Shelter, and local foster families.

Here's how it works:

- 1. Visit the Mercy Tree in the church lobby and take one or more ornaments.
- 2. Fill out the info tag on the ornament and leave it in the Mercy Tree basket.
- 3. Purchase the item(s) listed on your ornament(s).
- 4. Follow instructions on the ornament for wrapping and returning the gifts.

The ornaments will be up on the tree from Sunday, Nov. 23, to Sunday, Dec. 14; all gifts/gift cards must be returned to the church by Sunday, Dec. 14. We will also be looking for volunteers to help deliver the Angel Tree gifts the week of Dec. 21. If you are interested in helping deliver, please note that on the info tag you leave in the Mercy Tree basket. Thank you!



Hello Church Family!

My name is Justin Hunter, and you may recall hearing bits of my story over the spring and summer. I have been a part of CDA Bible since I was a young boy. Last fall, I went to a Discipleship Training School through Youth With A Mission (YWAM) Yosemite. Over the course of those six months, God pulled me out of the darkness of depression and began planting the seeds for the next seasons of my life. God has confirmed over the summer that He is calling me into missions with YWAM Yosemite.

YWAM is an international mission organization focused on training and mobilizing young folks to share the gospel with the unreached. The "Unreached" are classified as people or groups who will never hear the gospel unless someone from outside their culture comes and shares it with them. A nation is considered unreached if less than 2% of its population identifies as Christian. YWAM Yosemite focuses on a few such nations, including Japan, Armenia, Thailand, and Lebanon.

If you would like to join this mission of sharing the gospel and reaching the unreached, I invite you to join me in prayer and, if you're able, to become a monthly donor to support me financially. As a staff member of YWAM Yosemite, I will plan and lead local and international outreaches, train and disciple new Discipleship Training School students, plan and participate in worship and prayer events, and join in general base operations and upkeep. Your monthly donations are what will make all of that possible.

Please prayerfully consider being one of the people who help me reach my goal of \$2,000 every month. That will cover my basic and ministry needs. As always, my biggest ask is that you PRAY!
