The Assignons' Missionary Journey:

Edoh (Paul) Assignon heard the Word of God during an evangelistic campaign at a Baptist church in Lomé in 1974 and accepted Christ as his Savior at the end of the campaign. He was baptized the



following spring. He responded to God's call to become a full-time pastor in 1983 and received his Bible training in Togo and at Baptist Bible College in Clarks Summit, PA.

Paul and his wife Adzoa (Nicole) joined IGM in March, 2015. Paul has served in several churches. He has been involved in personal church-planting ministry since 1999 in French-speaking West Africa. The Lord has blessed this ministry greatly; there are presently 13 churches which have been planted in four regions in Togo and 10 national pastors working under Pastor Paul's oversight.

Prayer Requests:

- Pray for Pastor Paul as he oversees churches and schools in West Africa.
 Pray for the safety of those traveling, and ask the Lord to provide for their ongoing needs as they build and improve facilities to serve families and proclaim the gospel in their communities.
- Pray for Nicole and the family as they face challenges, including chronic health issues for their daughter Deborah. Pray that they will have access to better medical care in Niger. They write, "We are still planning to fly our daughter, Deborah, to the Republic of Niger for her fourth surgery as we mentioned in our previous newsletter. Please continue praying for God's provisions for all these expenses when the time comes. We plan to go after the school year ends or on August 20th – 27th."
- Pray for the growing number of non-Christian students and their families who choose a Christian school where the gospel is included in their lessons. Pray that their hearts will open to the truth of God's word and that they will become believers in Jesus!


