#### Pursue the transforming works of the Spirit of Holiness to:

grow within you great faith in God. Mark 11:22-24
grow within you incorruptible love of God. Ephesians 6:24
teach you to worship God in true humility. John 4:23-24; James 4:10; 1 Peter 5:6

One approach to working with the Spirit to grow your faith, love and humble worship: Read through the psalms, creating a list, of everything that God is, God does, and God promises (often simply the Psalmist describing God's goodness and nature).

Pray through your list, one line item at a time, asking the Spirit to reveal to you if the specific thing described is already your default, your norm, in your daily relations with God. If the Spirit reveals this small part of your relationship with God is already empowered and authored by Him, cross the item off and move on to the next. If this one thing is not yet habituated, pursue the Spirit daily to make this a reality in your relations with and worship of God until He witnesses to your heart that He has completed this small work within you. Cross that one off and move on to the next one.

As you, in this way, allow the Spirit of Christ to transform you (until we all attain to the fullness of the stature of Christ" Ephesians 4:13), the fruit of this deepening koinonia with God will flow out from your life as the promised 'rivers of living water'. All the promised fruits and all the expectations of scripture will be manifested by the Spirit as 'the love of God controls you' 2 Corinthians 5:14 the life of Christ is revealed through you.

# Apart From Me You Can Do Nothing Following Jesus, Who Walked in the Spirit

'Missions' is quite simply the revealing of the glory of God, from His earthly dwelling place – His temples – His people – His Church. This is, from beginning to end, a work of the Holy Spirit – the Spirit of Glory, of Power, of Grace, Revelation, Love, Truth, Wisdom and Knowledge, Holiness, Life, etc.

God's saints are, both individually and corporately, His intended primary means of revealing His goodness, light, love, and light to the nations. He dwells within our bodies, His temples, no differently than how He dwelt among His people in the tabernacle and temples in the Old Testament. From there He manifests the various forms of His glory – love, goodness, light, wisdom, truth, hope, comfort, healing, peace and joy, etc..

The glory to be revealed is His alone. But the vessel He has chosen in which to dwell and reveal Himself from on the earth is the physical bodies of His children of Light. Allowing Him to fulfill this purpose He has for us is what we call missions — missional living. But it happens, in truth, only when we are worshiping Lord Jesus in truth.

"Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither can you unless you abide in Me. I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing. John 15:4-5

To what 'form' of Himself was the 'Me' referring (in vs 5)? The next chapter makes it clear: "when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come. He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose it to you. All things that the Father has are Mine; therefore I said that He takes of Mine and will disclose it to you." John 16:13-15

Jesus said it would be His Spirit Who would be doing God's holy work within, among and through us rather than Himself continuing to be present in bodily form. In other words, without His spiritual form present and imparting the power and glory of godliness, we are incapable of any good thing.

#### Without the Spirit of God actively working, we can do NOTHING.

- --Nothing holy can be done without a work of Jesus' Spirit of Holiness.
- --Nothing wise without our Lord's Spirit of Wisdom disclosing holy wisdom.
- --Nothing gracious without Jesus' Spirit of Grace delivering the grace within us.
  - --Nothing glorious until the Lord's Spirit of Glory is manifesting His glory.

--No one can reveal Christ among the nations unless the Spirit of Revelation authors the manifestation.

Unless we believers are abiding, filled with the Spirit of holiness, peace, power, love, wisdom, and glory ...nothing good, nothing Christlike, nothing missional, can happen.

Our part in this 'missional life' IS NOT an attempt to produce something glorious.

All we have besides Jesus' Holy Spirit is weak flesh – 'No good thing'. Psalm 16:2

Therefore our part is the 'worshiping in spirit and in truth' John 4:23-24 which Jesus told the woman at the well was the one thing the Father was seeking.

Our part is the 'fixing our eyes on Jesus' Hebrews 12:2 which the Lord told Martha was the 'good thing' Mary was doing which pleased Him. Luke 10:41-42

Our part is crying out in faith and humility to the Spirit of God to transform us, that we may learn to 'walk in the spirit' Galatians 5:16,25; Romans 8:1,4 and thereby 'in the light' John 8:12, Ephesians 5:8, 1 John 1:7

The missional life worships in spirit and in truth, until the Divine Nature 2 Peter 1:3-4 (which the Spirit has already formed within every true believer) – the fount from which the 'rivers of living water' John 7:38-39 are meant to flow, is filled to overflowing by the Spirit of Glory.

We must pursue the Spirit of Christ to transform our lives until this 'walking in the Spirit and in the light' has become our default – our habit – our Way. We must constantly cry out to Him to cause the Divine Nature He has given to be empowered by His Spirit to reveal His glory to the nations through us. This is the biblical meaning of 'Christian missions'.

So HOW do we grow to that place where, by His Spirit, we are walking in the Light as He is in the Light?


# Missions Trip 2025 Girona, Spain
