Fall 2024 Update from Russ and Karyn Smyth:

Russ shares: I traveled to Germany to visit our

Anchored team. I spent most of the time south of Munich, helping Abe Penner pack for moving to another town, taking long walks and talking about ministry. We spent several evenings in Munich, teaching Bible studies and building relationships with immigrants and refugees. Then I traveled by train to Detmold, Germany to see Johannes and Agata. It was a joy to see how their church is growing and to meet some of the people from their Bible studies.

From Germany I traveled by train to Warsaw, then I took a bus to Kyiv, Ukraine. I arrived before daylight and was immediately welcomed and given a security briefing. My good friend Craig Hampton has been there serving with Samaritans Purse, along with believers from many countries who are spreading the gospel and distributing humanitarian aid during this time of war.

The city of Kyiv is under missile attack almost every night, but they are able to intercept most of the missiles before they land. My first night in Kyiv the air raid alerts went off around 10pm, and before I could ask Craig what to do, we heard a large explosion outside, as one of the missiles was shot down. Another night a missile got through and hit an apartment building, killing a 15 year old girl and injuring many others.

As we toured the city, it was very sobering to see memorials to the thousands of people who have died in the war. I was amazed to see how the Lord has blessed Craig and his team with courage to assist the people of Ukraine in this time of trouble. Whether delivering the Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes, or giving people flashlights, blankets, food and water, the gospel is going boldly to many people who might not otherwise ever hear the Good News.

Thanks again for your partnership in our ministry through your prayers, encouragement, and support. We are reminded of God's faithfulness and love for us daily, and you are a huge part of that.






