2 Corinthians 1:3-11 sums up what we are feeling these days. Yes, we have days of discouragement and times of questioning. But we are comforted and encouraged through so many of you who have prayed for us, reached out to us in various ways, financial help, words of Truth, your understanding as we navigate it all, and so much more. Thank you from the bottom of our hearts. It makes the burden more bearable.

We just wanted to give a quick update about what we have learned regarding Diego's health. Praise the Lord, we do have some answers! After almost 2 months of waiting for specific test results, we have found that the main root issue of almost all of Diego's symptoms is bacteria. He is in a type of detox treatment right now and often feels awful. In those moments, it is hard to remember that it is part of the process and soon, Lord willing, he will be healing and feeling better.

We are praying to be able to return soon to Mexico. We initially planned in to return in November, but trust that God will lead us accordingly. We are eager to return with our coworkers and the people in the village and to continue forward in the ministry. But we also know that health is vital and that Diego needs to be well in order to function in the ministry. That is why we are here in the states in the first place! It is so important to take care in that way.

- Pray for us to trust God fully in His perfect timing.
- Pray for us to rest in Him and to have peace instead of feeling unsettled.
- Pray for encouragement daily and that our faith in Him would grow deeper.
- Pray for our coworkers who are working hard by themselves!

- Pray as we prepare for our return soon (Lord willing); we have some bigger items we are prayerfully looking to purchase before returning (a bigger trailer and a new cell phone for Diego, to name a couple.).
- Praise the Lord for answers and provision on Diego's health journey!
- Praise the Lord the kids have been healthy and happy!
- Praise the Lord for His love and faithfulness in our lives that we see daily.

Thank you for coming alongside and carrying the burden with us. We will continue to update as we are able. Thank you for your prayers for us all!



Rebuilding Foundations


