The number of the people the Lord brought to Himself; about those who were baptized; the blessings and the hard times we had; the progress and the family and ministry needs. Every pastor couple went well to their homes.

We continue with church building construction in Kara, Temple Shalom. We are getting ready for the concrete roof of the church. The church members have been working on the last Saturday and Sunday of the month after church service. Everybody and even the children are happy to do something. This concrete roof will serve as the floor of the continuation of the school classrooms. This Saturday will be the day when this great job will be done. We will need to start at 5 am and it can take us up to 9 pm because the job needs to finish the same day it was started. Please, continue praying that the Lord may provide for all these needs regarding the ministry.
