QUALITY CHECK: Our shoppers appreciate the quality of our gently used items. Before bringing anything to the church, please ensure all items are clean and in good repair, and free of stains or mechanical issues (missing parts, etc.). Your pre-screening of items before drop-off will aid our volunteers as they set up the sale and prevent unnecessary trips to the landfill with things not in sale condition.

DROP OFF: You can begin dropping off donations at the gym loading dock from August 17 to 21, Monday through Friday, 9:00-5:00. If you must drop off earlier, contact Marilee for options. She will work with you!

BIG OR HEAVY ITEMS: Contact Marilee if you have large or heavy items to donate so she can list them on Facebook Marketplace and save you a trip. Buyers can pick them up directly at your house or storage site, so you move them only once, and CBC still receives donations for our ministry fund.
