We had another graduation of the Foundational Bible Teaching and Discipleship Program that we started years ago. It was a privilege to teach alongside

with my Tanzanian brothers and one of our Ethnos360 co-worker (Abel Miller).

This group started the program last year. First, they went through the Eternity to Eternity approach "chronological lessons", where they were exposed to the "foundation" of the Scriptures and got to discover in a deeper way who is our Father God, His character, attributes and promises, they also understood better the beginning of the redemption plan through our Lord Jesus Christ (started back in Genesis and see it through the whole Scriptures), as well as the role of the Holy Spirit. In few words they were able to see the whole picture on regards God and His amazing salvation plan for humanity.

If you had listened to some of the testimonies of the graduates, I [bet] you would be excited and maybe some tears would have come out. It was just wonderful to see the powerful impact that the Word of God can do in the hearts of His servants. I want to thank my father God, my Savior Jesus and the Holy Spirit for giving me an opportunity that is clear I don't deserve, teaching is one of my favorite things in ministry, but when we do it to equip His people in Tanzania, then it becomes super exciting and it humbles myself at the same time.


- Please pray that our world political leaders would have someone near them bold enough to clearly share the gospel so that they might come to faith in Jesus and rule their people with wisdom from God.
