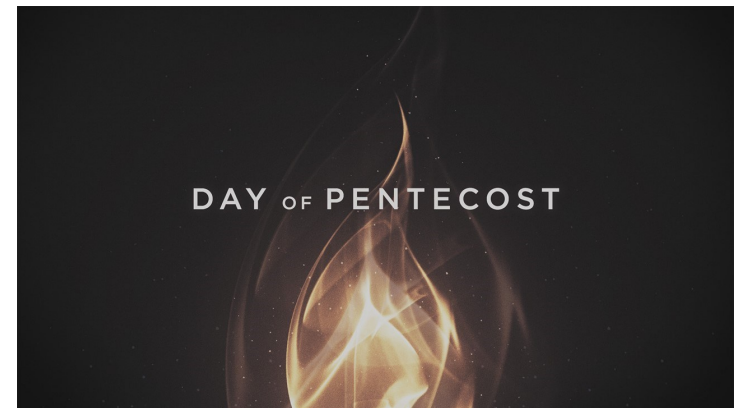

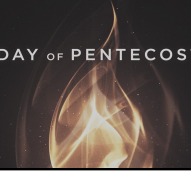
Group Discussion Questions
