



CBC's rummage sale is popular in our community and raises funds for various ministries each year. Last year, we raised over \$8,000 for women's ministries and missions!

#### **HOW IT WORKS:**

**QUALITY CHECK:** Our shoppers appreciate the quality of our *gently* used items. Before bringing anything to the church, *please* ensure all items are clean and in good repair, free of stains or mechanical issues (missing parts, etc.). Your prescreening of items before drop-off will aid our volunteers as they set up the sale and prevent unnecessary trips to the landfill with things not in sale condition.

**DROP OFF:** You can begin dropping off donations at the gym loading dock from August 19 to 23, Monday through Friday, 9:00-5:00. If you must drop off earlier, contact Marilee for options. She will work with you!

**BIG OR HEAVY ITEMS:** Contact Marilee if you have large or heavy items to donate so she can list them on Facebook Marketplace and save you a trip. Buyers can pick them up directly at your house or storage site, so you move them only once, and CBC still receives donations for our ministry fund.

**VOLUNTEER: You are invited** to volunteer to sort donations and set up for the sale. (You get to shop early, too!). Set-up days are open hours for volunteering; just come on in from 9:00 to 5:00. Sale day will be scheduled to ensure coverage all day from 8:00 to 3:00.

# CDA BIBLE CHURCH WOMEN'S WEEKEND AWAY SEPTEMBER 13-15, 2024

Women's Weekend Away is perfect for any gals who are sensing the need for a little downtime by the river!

The Craddock cabin is a mere 90-minute drive east on I-90, and carpooling will be encouraged!

The event is scaled back compared to last year's *Gals Getaway*, so there is a limited agenda. Some options for activities throughout the weekend include:

- outdoor activities, like walking and hiking
- sitting by (or even playing in) the river
- trip to Quinn's Hot Springs (extra fee)
- visiting with each other
- playing board games
- spiritual enrichment

#### Logistical info about the weekend:

- Meals: These will be planned out and groceries purchased in advance, and everyone will be assigned to a meal team so that the meal workload can be evenly distributed.
- Sleeping Arrangements: It's a big cabin, but beds are limited. Some of you
  will need to share a queen size bed with a roommate. Others will need to
  sleep on the floor with a sleeping pad, or on a couch.
- Cost: With the scaled-back approach comes a scaled-back price \$30 for the whole weekend - two nights and five meals or \$20 for Saturday only (arrive as early as 8 a.m. for breakfast and stay till after dinner)
- Limited Space: Registration is limited to 25 gals for the full weekend, with an additional 10 spaces available for the Saturday-only option.
- Quinn's Hot Springs info: Optional trip to the hot springs is an add-on cost of \$22 per person for a 4-hour slot; we're hoping to reserve the morning slot on Saturday the 14th, which is 8 a.m.-12 noon. If you think you will want to go to the hot springs, please complete the registration ASAP, as we have to make the reservation with Quinn's soon.
- Regarding Babies: Babes-in-arms are welcome to this weekend away.

Our Women's Ministry Director, Marilee, will send out more information and a suggested packing list for the weekend to those who are registered. Look for it around September 1st.
