Read 1 Peter 1:21-2:1. If you are going through these questions as a group, have someone read the passage aloud.

1. Look through 1 Peter 1. Make a list of all the verses where Peter makes some sort of reference to salvation. Why do you think Peter kept bringing his readers back to the topic of their spiritual rebirth?
2. What were the circumstances that led you to place your faith and hope in Jesus? How has your decision to trust Jesus served as an anchor for your life?
3. In verse 22, Peter describes a very practical and particular practice that should flow out of our salvation. What is it? Why would this be a natural outflow of being saved by Jesus?
4. How does love for one another strengthen the church? What happens if members of Christ's church fail to love one another?
5. What do the following scriptures teach about the absolute importance for Christians to love one another? John 13:34; Romans 13:8; 1 Peter 4:8; 1 John 4:11; John 15:3
6. What are some practical ways the followers of Jesus can show love to one another?
7. According to verse 22, how does Peter describe the longevity of our new life in Christ? Why is it important to know this about our relationship with God?
8. What was Peter's point in quoting Isaiah 4:6-8 in verses 24-25?
