Meets in the Prayer Room

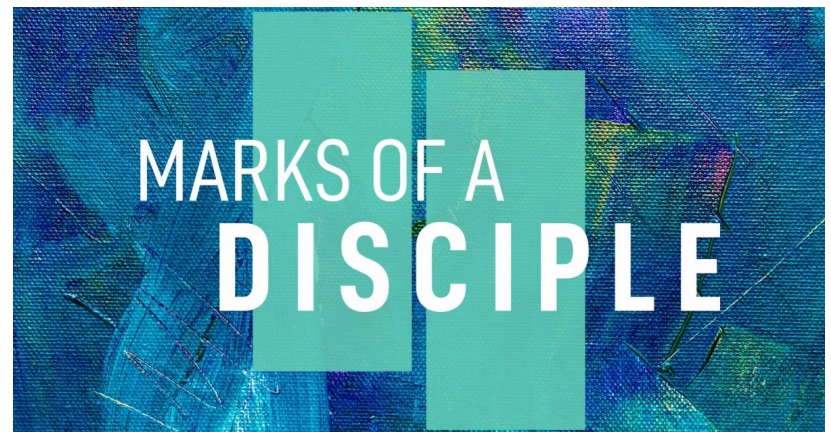
If you are 18 to 30 years old, this night is for you.
