Thanks again for all your prayers. The training in Arusha city was wonderful, we saw God in action! It was amazing to see the "transformation" in the minds and hearts of the participants, the Word of God never comes back empty.

- WHAT WE TEACH IN THIS DISCIPLESHIP PROGRAM -

Chronological Teaching: Very similar to Firm Foundations, however we start in Genesis and finish in Revelation. This helps the students to see the Bible as a whole and not just a bunch of stories that are hard to connect if you don't see the "big picture."

New Life in Christ: A detailed study based on Romans and 1 & 2 Thessalonians that it is all about our new identity in Christ, living in the Spirit as new creatures and understanding our duties as believers.

Kairos: This is a 1-week condensed missions training. It helps to raise awareness about why we should reach all the nations for Christ. It also gives a "new perspective" when we want to reach people from other religions.

Follow up with Practical Steps for One Year: After the participants finish the whole program, then we co-teach their local churches. We still are together coaching them and following up with their new assignments. We actually share the "pulpit" teaching and debriefing together in the areas they still need to grow. In this stage they only teach chronological lessons.

Now you have a better understanding of what we mean when we say we run a DISCIPLESHIP PROGRAM, which is basically equipping to equip others!


