Group Discussion Questions

Read through 1 Peter 4:1-6. If you are going through these questions as a group, have someone read the passage aloud.

1. Looking at verse 1, what does Peter have to say about suffering? Why is suffering something Christians are called to identify rather than avoid?

2. Although suffering is never enjoyable, God is able to use suffering to accomplish different purposes in our lives. What types of positive things can be produced when we endure suffering as a Christian? Can you think of a way suffering has actually helped you become a better disciple?

3. Considering verses 2-3, how important is it to fully leave behind our old life without Christ in order to embrace our new life in Jesus? Why is it so important to make a break from the old in favor of the new? What makes this transition difficult? How does God want to help us?

4. For some, becoming a Christian means our old relationships are affected. What kind of potential negative impact is described in verse 4? Why are some people so annoyed and/or insulted when someone they know comes to Christ? And, as Christians, how do we best represent Jesus when our friendships are strained because of our faith?

5. As a Christian, how should the fact that every human being is responsible before God make us think and feel? And beyond what we think and feel about our friends, family, and neighbors, what should this reality cause us to do?
