We are so happy and grateful that we have returned to our home. It is a blessing to see our friends and coworkers once again. But it hasn't been easy, per usual! We have had quite the job getting our home into livable conditions once again as we needed to do various repairs/projects, take care of mold, and figuring out the puzzle of fitting 8 people into a one room house! We are thankful Diego's parents and sister were with us for a bit to help where needed.

As always, it has been a bit of a rough start, not only with the house but also with sickness. We currently are quarantined for Hepatitis A. This illness has put us a bit behind in our schedule and plan to start up language study, but we trust the Lord's perfect timing and purpose. We have about one week left of quarantine. In the meantime, we will try to get some projects done in the house, get fully settled and in a good routine with the kids so that we can begin our work well, and hopefully get some much needed rest.

We were able to find a one room little house in a town significantly closer to the village that we have been fixing up to be able to stay in 2-3 days a week for language study. We are surrounded by Tseltales there and have been able to get to know our neighbor and hope he and his wife may help us with language study.

- Please pray for our recovery from Hepatitis A.
- Please pray for the kids as we figure out a good schedule and rhythm with homeschooling, and for wisdom and patience for Tammi as she navigates that.
- Please pray for Diego as he struggles with allergies in different seasons here.
- Please pray we can find land soon to begin building a home. Pray for wisdom and discernment as we search.
- Please pray for us to build good relationships and rapport with Tseltal people.
- Please pray for our coworkers, Vicente and Betty. Vicente and his brothers are working on lessons to teach a group of Tseltal people. Pray for understanding and salvation. And please pray for Betty as she continues to learn the language.
- Please pray for diligence and patience as we learn the culture and language it is not easy! But we are eager to learn and keep moving forward in the ministry.
- Please pray that we would always look to the Lord for strength and encouragement as we face our daily battles and difficulties, and that we not forget our priorities and primary purpose. Pray for our continual growth in Him!

Thank you so much for your part in this ministry and all that you do! You are a blessing to us and we thank God for you!




