This includes a set of 10 swings, 2 slides and 2 monkey bars. Yeah! The whole process required many meetings with the community leaders. - Pray for our mission partners, the Anyons, who serve alongside us in this mission.




GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS





Pastor Kurt and Sara Staeuble are leading a marriage series this fall where we will gain a greater theological understanding of what God



DISCIPLESHIP GROUPS (D-GROUPS)


D-Groups: All adults are invited to join a discipleship group. Growing an inti-

Calling all senior adult men and women!


