## Group Discussion Questions for Further Reflection

Read Acts 4:23-31, and reflect on the following questions:

1. In verses 25-26, the believers quote from Psalm 2; what connection are they making in remembering Psalm 2 and the experience Peter and John had with the council?
2. In verse 24, the believers make a statement of belief about who God is; how does that statement pertain to Psalm 2?
3. In verse 27 the believers continue thinking about Psalm 2, and see a connection with the life and ministry of Jesus; what connection do they see? How do these statements from their prayer connect to Peter's writing in 1 Peter 3:13-22?
4. In verses 29-30, what do the believers ask for in this passage considering their present circumstances? Do they pray for rescue from their enemies? Do they pray that their enemies will be defeated? What do they ask God to do for them, and what do they ask God to do through them?
5. In verse 31, how does God respond to their prayers? What might their response mean? Does God seem pleased by this?
6. What would it look like for a church like ours to follow the example of the early church here?
