Group Discussion Questions

Read 1 Peter 1:6-12. If working through these questions as a group, have someone read the passage aloud.

1. What directive does Peter give to his readers in verse 6, and what reason does Peter say makes his directive possible?
2. According to verse 7, what value can be found in trials? What does Peter say is of more worth than gold? Why do you think God sometimes allows our faith to be tested? What might spiritual refining look like in a believer's life?
3. How does the joy of our salvation impact our outlook on life (particularly life's challenges) and our ability to endure hardships?
4. How does this first part of 1 Peter 1:8 correlate with what is written in Hebrews 11:1?
5. Reread 1 Peter 1:10-12. Who knows more about the Messiah, the prophets or us? Is it better to know a few select things revealed directly by God (as the prophets did) or all of God's revealed plan (as we do)?
6. Can you think of any Old Testament prophecies that speak of the coming Messiah, whether it be his glories or his sufferings?
7. What response do angels have to God's unfolding plan of redemption? Why do you think Peter included this bit of information in his letter?

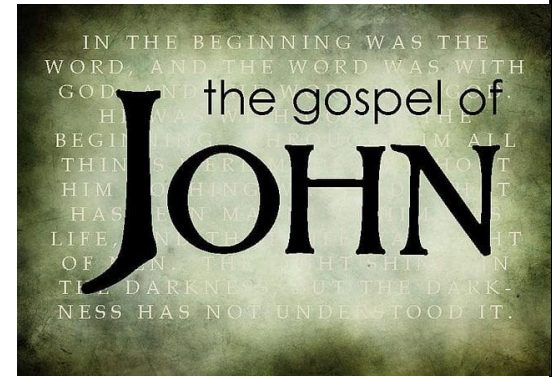

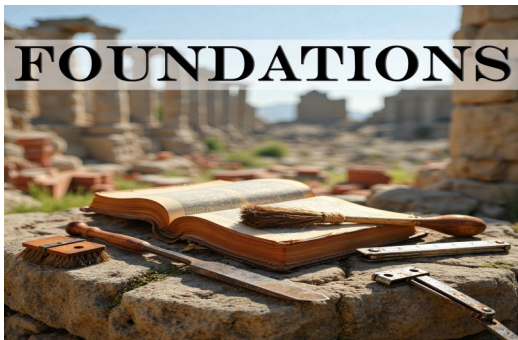

Join us for Foundations, an adult Sunday School class exploring the core beliefs and theology of the Christian faith. Together, we will study the great truths of Scripture in an organized and accessible way. This class aims to strengthen our confidence in God's Word and provide a framework for faithful Christian living through a thorough understanding of the Bible, God, Christ, the Holy Spirit, man, salvation, and the church. We will be building a strong theological foundation that shapes how we think, live, and worship. All are welcome.

Key Benefits of Studying Theology

- **Builds Coherent Beliefs:** Organizes the Bible's diverse teachings into logical categories (like Bibliology, Christology, Soteriology) for a comprehensive understanding, preventing a fragmented faith.
- **Answers Big Questions:** Draws on Scripture to address fundamental questions about God, humanity, evil, purpose, and history.
- **Promotes Spiritual Growth:** Deepens knowledge of God, leading to greater Christlikeness and a more robust relationship with Him, as eternal life involves knowing God.
- **Guards Against Error:** Helps discern false teachings, correct misinterpretations, and challenge personal biases or assumptions.
- **Forms a Christian Worldview:** Provides a framework to view all of life through a biblical lens, applying Scripture to every domain.
- **Ensures Faithful Preaching:** Enables preachers to teach the "whole counsel of God," not just appealing or popular parts.
- **Clarifies Biblical Language:** Highlights the Bible's unique use of common words (such as "justice" and "love") in profound, distinctive ways, preventing secular misunderstandings.
- **Encourages Practical Living:** Makes theology relevant and applicable to daily decisions, fostering worship and godly character.

In essence, studying theology helps believers move from knowing isolated Bible stories to understanding what the Bible teaches as a unified whole, leading to a deeper, more grounded faith and life.

The study of theology enables us to teach ourselves and others what the whole Bible says, thus fulfilling the "teaching" part of the Great Commission.
