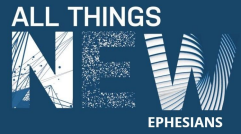
GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. To get started, read through this week's passage, Ephesians 6:18-24. If you are going through these questions as part of a group, have someone read the passage aloud.
2. Look at verse 18. What types of instructions does Paul provide in this verse? Why are each of these directives important to practice?
3. Read verses 19-20. What did Paul ask the Ephesians to pray for on his behalf? Why is what Paul requested vital to the success of his ministry?
4. In verses 21-21, Paul brings up the topic of one of his co-workers, a man named Tychicus. What two tasks did Paul give to Tychicus to accomplish? Tychicus is mentioned in 4 other places in the New Testament: Acts 20:4, Colossians 4:7, 2 Timothy 4:12, Titus 3:12. If you have time, look these verses up to get more insight about Tychicus!
5. Paul wraps up this passage with a prayer for the Ephesians. What does Paul ask God to do for his beloved friends in Ephesus? Of all the things Paul prayed for, which one appeals to you the most?
6. Paul talked a lot about prayer in this passage, but prayer is something people often struggle working into their lives. Why can prayer be such a challenge for some? And what might we do to overcome our challenges to prayer and see more prayer happening in our life?
7. In verse 18, Paul wrote about "staying alert and persistent" in regard to praying for others. Here's a challenge: this week, ask God to make you more aware of what's going on in the lives of people around so you can pray for them consistently and specifically.
8. What's the most important thing you learned by spending time in this passage?
