Group Discussion Questions

Read 1 Peter 1:17-20. If you are working through these questions as a group, have someone read the passage aloud.

1. What does it mean to you that “God doesn’t play favorites?” How would this fact comfort a Christian who is living rightly? How might it concern a Christian who is living in disobedience?
2. When Peter writes about judgment in verse 17, he’s not referring to salvation. So, what type of judgment is he referring to?
3. In verse 17, Peter makes reference to the importance of reverence. What does reverence look like in everyday life? Is reverence more of an internal thing as opposed to an external thing?
4. What does Peter mean when he refers to his readers as “temporary residents.” How should this designation impact how we live here on earth?
5. What does Peter write about the price that Jesus paid for our salvation in verses 18-20? How is this meant to be an encouragement to his readers?
6. Two times in the passage Peter uses the word “ransom.” What does this word have to do with the process of our salvation?
7. Toward the end of his message, Pastor Kurt talked about the “danger of distractions.” How do distractions keep us from staying focused on our pursuit of Jesus? What types of distractions do you typically find yourself having to deal with day in and day out?


