YOUTH GROUP SUMMER CAMP!

Registration opens Thursday, March 13, 9:00 AM PST

Youth Summer Camp at Stonewater Adventure Camp registration will open Thursday, March 13th at 9am PST. To register your student, go to cdabible.org. Find the red "Next Steps" tab in the bottom right corner of the home page and click on "Next Steps." Find "2025 Youth Summer Camp" and follow the steps to register your student!

TYPES OF ADVENTURE CAMPS—JULY 20-25, 2025

There will be two choices of "camps" within the registration flow. These two choices are only available to high school students. Middle school students will be able to participate only in "Base Camp Adventures." High school students have the choice to participate in either "Base Camp Adventures" or "River Kayak Adventures." We will spend the first two days of camp together before we split up into our separate groups.

Base Camp Adventures: Day adventure camp! Stonewater will be your spot of sleep and reset, every day your student will be able to embark on a different adventure for the day! These adventures are kayaking across a lake, rock climbing with trained professionals, hiking the Pacific Coast Trail, etc.

River Kayak Adventure: This is a 3-day overnight trip kayaking on the Methow River in Washington State. Your student will be kayaking, sleep out under the stars, and hanging out with their fellow students all while being supervised by trained professionals in kayaking and rapids! THIS CHOICE IS FOR HIGH SCHOOL ONLY!

LIMITED SPACE FOR THE ENTIRE CAMP!

Unfortunately, Stonewater has put a limit on the number of people who can come and be a part of the summer camp! Only 16 students will be able to register for the Base Camp and only 13 students will be able to register for the Kayak Camp. So please register quickly! We cannot make any more space available like we did for this year's winter camp per Stonewater's guidelines.

COST

- At this time when you are registering you will be asked to pay a \$100 deposit to secure your student's spot. This is required to complete the registration process.
- The ballpark total cost of the entire camp will be around \$400. However, this is subject to change per the Soup/Chili Cookoff Fundraiser on March 26th.
- Individual fundraisers such as bake sales will be available for students to participate in after the soup and chili cookoff to help each student lower their cost out of pocket.
