This seminar is hosted by all three of our pastors, so it's a great way to hear their hearts about the things that matter most to God.

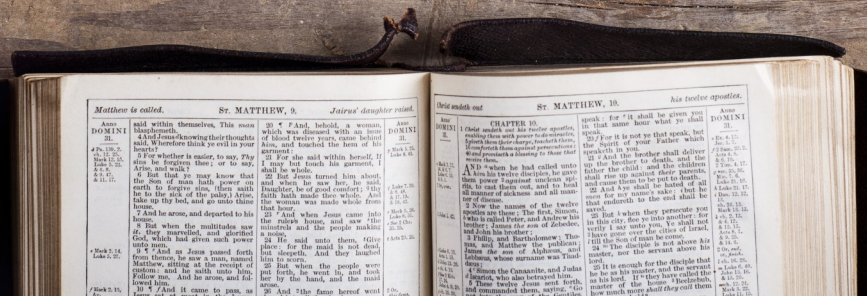
