Praise the Lord Nicole had her injections in both knees. Her pains are almost gone, and she is now using only one cane and sometimes none. She is taking prescriptions. I am doing well after my back injury from lifting cement blocks while working on the school building.

The Lord is really at work in our midst here. Our school is one year old. We have added four classes. We built these classes during the last vacation time. We will need more classrooms for next year, but we do not have any more space on this land to build that. There is a piece of land near us for sale and we are looking to the Lord to provide us about \$22,000 to purchase it.

The academic year 2022-23 started in September. Those among us who travelled for vacation came back and several had to leave for another part of the country. The Lord brought new children to our school and the number tripled compared to last year. This year there are many Muslims in the school. Unfortunately, many of these children and their parents are not worshipping the true God. We have introduced Bible study time in our school program. Even the little children are getting what they have been taught from God's word. Some of these children started coming to church on Sunday! Our orphans are doing well. We enrolled two more of them in our school. We now have seven orphans in our school!

We have had some difficulties with holding church and church activities in the open due to government restrictions. We have finished the foundation of the building, but we need God's provision to finish the construction. The Lord continues to faithfully add souls to the congregation.
